#### Had+v3

- He studied his lessons. Then he slept.
- After he **had studied** his lessons, he **slept**.
- Before he slept, he had studied his lessons.

#### Examples with Before

She had eaten **before** the movie started.

They had left **before** we arrived.

He had finished his homework **before** dinner.

before, by the time, when

#### Examples with After

**After** she had cooked, they ate.

The train left **after** we had waited.

He called **after** I had gone to bed.

### The passive voice for Present Continuous, Past Continuous, and Present Perfect tenses

#### Present Continuous Passive

am/is/are + being + past participle (V3).

1. The cake is being eaten now.
2. The room is being cleaned by the maid.
3. Books are being read in the library.

#### Past Continuous Passive

was/were + being + past participle (V3).

1. The house was being painted yesterday.
2. Dinner was being cooked when I arrived
3. Letters were being written by the students.

#### Present Perfect Passive

have/has + been + past participle (V3).

1. The work has been finished.
2. The car has been washed by my brother.
3. Many gifts have been given to the children.

#### Time Period

Something happens in a period of time.

Example:

I fell asleep during the movie.



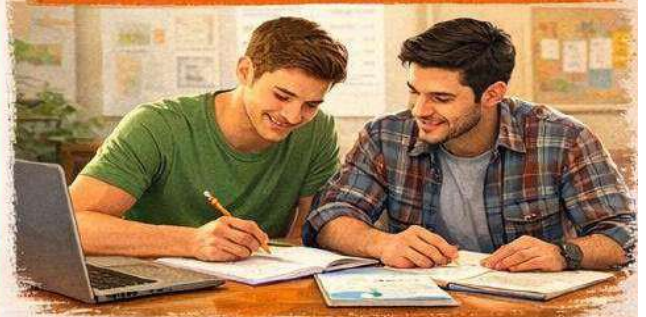
### FOR

#### Purpose / Reason

Shows the *reason* for an action.

Example:

We met after class for a group project.



### BY

#### Transport Method

Shows the way of travel.

Example:

She traveled by plane.



### BETWEEN

#### Linking Two Things

Connects two places or people.

Example:

The park is between the school and the mall.
